17 So all the generations from A'bra-
ham to Da'vid are fourteen generations;
and from Da'vid until the carrying away
into Bab'y-lon are fourteen generations;
and from the carrying away into Bab'y-lon
unto Christ are fourteen generations.

18 Now the birth of Jē'sus Christ was
on this wise: When as his mother Mā'ry
was espoused to Jō'seph, before they came
together, she was found with child of the
Holy Ghost.

19 Then Jō'seph her husband, being a
just man, and not willing to make her a
public example, was minded to put her
away privily.

20 But while he thought on these things,
behold, the angel of the Lord appeared
unto him in a dream, saying, Jō'seph,
thou son of Da'vid, fear not to take unto
thee Mā'ry thy wife; for that which is
conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost.

21 And she shall bring forth a son, and
thou shalt call his name Jē'SUS; for he
shall save his people from their sins.

22 Now all this was done, that it might
be fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord
by the prophet, saying,

10 When they saw the star, they re-
joiced with exceeding great joy.

11 And when they were come into the
house, they saw the young child with
Mā'ry his mother, and fell down, and wor-
shipped him; and when they had opened
their treasures, they presented unto him
gifts; gold, and frankincense, and myrrh.

12 And being warned of God in a dream
that they should not return to Hēr'od,
they departed into their own country
another way.

13 And when they were departed, be-
hold, the angel of the LORD appeareth to
Jō'seph in a dream, saying, Arise, and
take the young child and his mother, and
flee unto E'gypt, and be thou there until
I bring thee word: for Hēr'od will seek the
young child, to destroy him.

14 When he arose, he took the young
child and his mother by night, and de-
parted into E'gypt:

15 And was there until the death of
Hēr'od, that it might be fulfilled which
was spoken of the Lord by the prophet,
saying, Out of E'gypt have I called my son.
